THIS MATTER having come before the Nevada Taxicab Authority Board ("the Board"), at its regularly scheduled public meeting on August 19, 2026, ("the Hearing"), for the consideration of adopting/amending/appealing permanent regulations for Chapter 706 (Nevada Taxicab Authority) of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). The Hearing was held at the Nevada State Business Center, located at 3300 West Sahara Avenue, Suite 400, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

The proposed permanent new NAC regulations, amendments to existing NAC provisions, and the repeal of certain NAC regulations in Chapter 706 (collectively hereinafter the "new regulations") and also known as LCB File No. R006-25, without substantial revisions, were discussed at length with the public and with the taxicab industry. The Nevada Taxicab Authority ("the Authority") held two lengthy informal meetings with the industry in both January and February 2025, and four public Workshops with the Board in March and April 2025 and again in February and June 2026. Few changes were made to the proposed new regulations during the April 2025 Workshop with clarifications by staff being discussed. Changes from the March 2025 Workshop were publicly noticed and discussed during the April Workshop. After the December 2025 receipt of LCB File No. R006-25,

1 two additional public Workshops were held to discuss the LCB changes and any additional language  
2 changes that were needed. All Workshop agendas, the drafts of the new regulations and the Small  
3 Business Impact Statements were made available and noticed on the Authority's website, as well as at  
4 the Nevada State Library and Archives, the Nevada Legislature Administrative Regulation notices  
5 website and the State of Nevada website. The Notice of Public Hearing and Notice of Hearing for  
6 Adoption of the Rules were posted at the Business and Industry Building in Las Vegas, Nevada, with  
7 the Capitol Police, the Clark County Commission, Las Vegas City Hall, the Taxicab Authority, and  
8 shared with the local Chambers of Commerce.

10 The Board conducted public comments sessions regarding the adoption of the permanent  
11 regulations during the Workshops and Public Hearings. Moreover, a number of opportunities were  
12 given to the public to provide input as to any small business impacts that might result from adoption  
13 of the new regulations. The Authority informed the Board in the public hearings that there were no  
14 financial impacts reported by the public on any of the Small Business Impact Statements submitted by  
15 the public. Based on the evidence presented to the Board and following consideration of the  
16 information presented during the Hearing, the Board hereby enters the following Findings of Fact,  
17 Conclusions of Law and Order (the "**Decision**"):

### 19 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

20  
21 1. The administrative record in this matter consists of the Public Hearing Notice of Intent  
22 to Act Upon a Regulation; To Adopt Permanent Regulations/Amend Regulations/Repeal Regulations  
23 From Chapter 706 ( Nevada Taxicab Authority) of the Nevada Administrative Code; the Public  
24 Hearing Notice For the Adoption and Amendment of the Regulations of the State of Nevada Taxicab  
25 Authority; the Public Board Meeting Notices and Agendas; the text of the Proposed Permanent  
26 Regulations; and the four Small Business Impact Statements prepared by the Authority.

27 2. After discussion and deliberation, all members of the Board present at the Hearing,

1 having fully considered the law and being fully advised in the premises, accepted the Small Business  
2 Impact Statement provided by the Authority, and voted unanimously in favor of a motion to approve  
3 the adoption of the proposed Permanent Regulations as they were noticed for this August 19, 2026,  
4 hearing.

#### 5 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

6 1. The Hearing was held in compliance with the provisions of the Nevada Open Meeting  
7 Law, the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (the  
8 "NRS") and Chapter 706 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

9 2. The geographic area subject to this Order is Clark County, Nevada.

10 3. The Board is duly constituted and may regulate the conduct of the taxicab business.  
11  
12 NRS 706.8818.

13 4. The Board has the authority to ensure that the traveling public has access to readily  
14 available, safe and reliable transportation services. In furtherance of that objective, the Board  
15 concludes the public interest will be served by the adoption of Permanent Regulations.

16 5. The interests, welfare and convenience of the travelling public are served by the  
17 Board's adoption of the Permanent Regulations.

18 6. Public policy favors approval and adoption of these Proposed Permanent Regulations.

19 7. The Board's adoption of the Proposed Permanent Regulations is a reasonable and  
20  
21 permissible exercise of its authority to regulate the taxicab industry.

22 8. If any of the foregoing conclusions of law is more appropriately construed as a finding  
23 of fact, it may be so construed.
